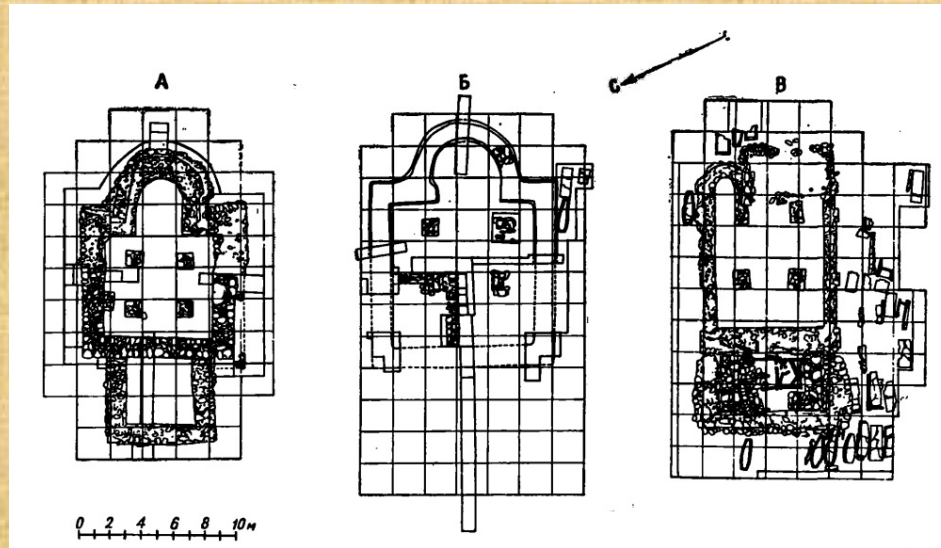

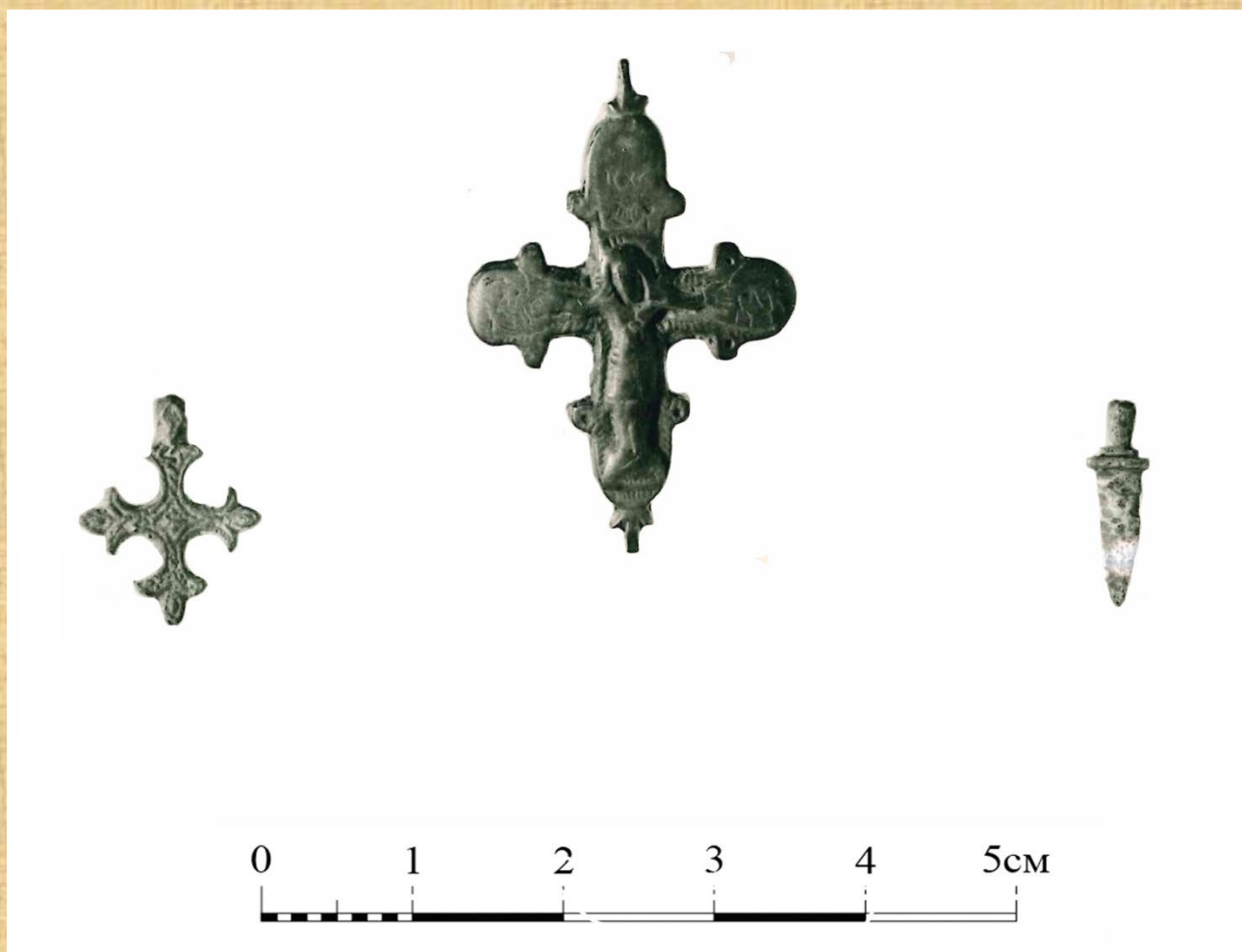

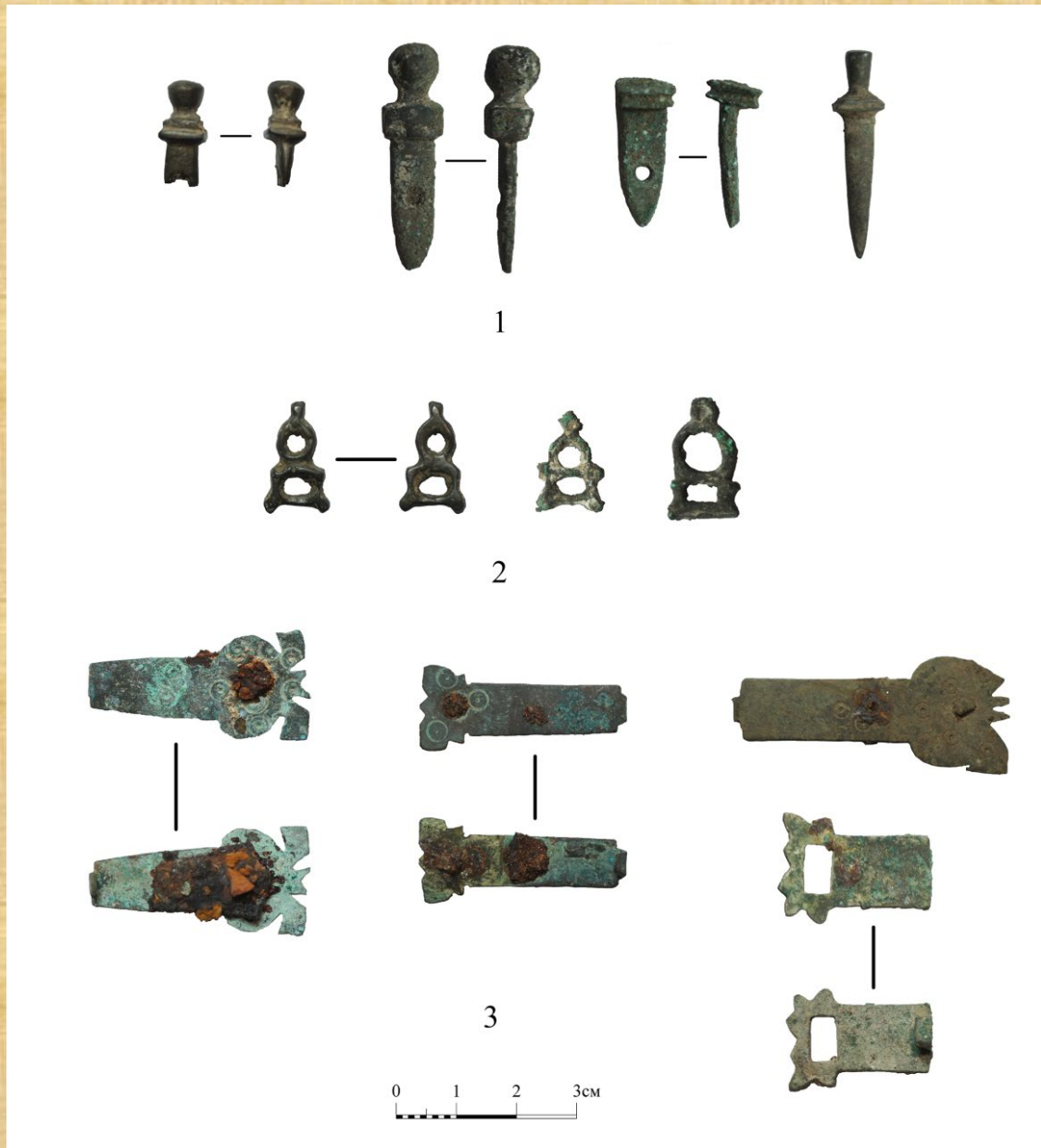

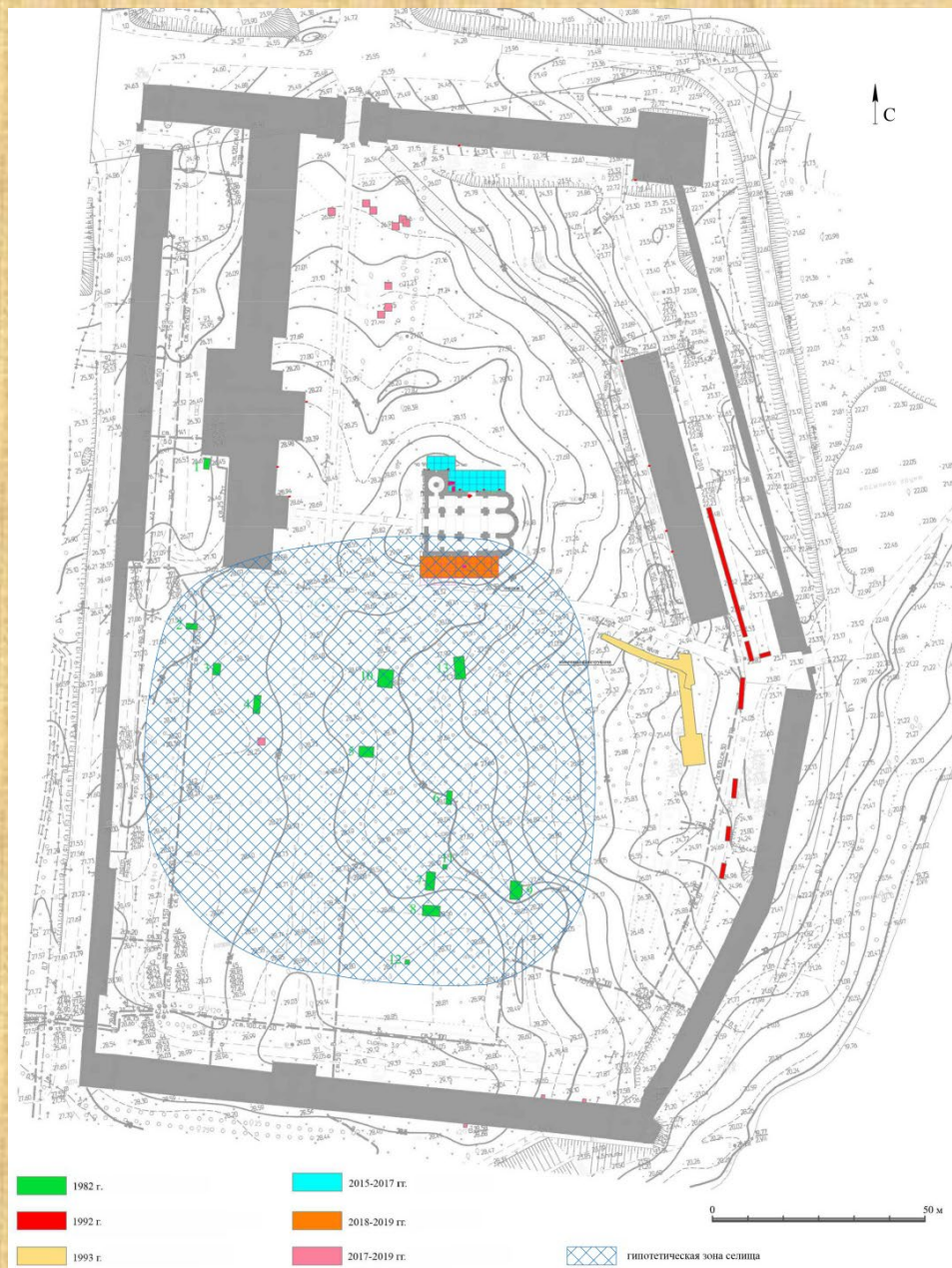

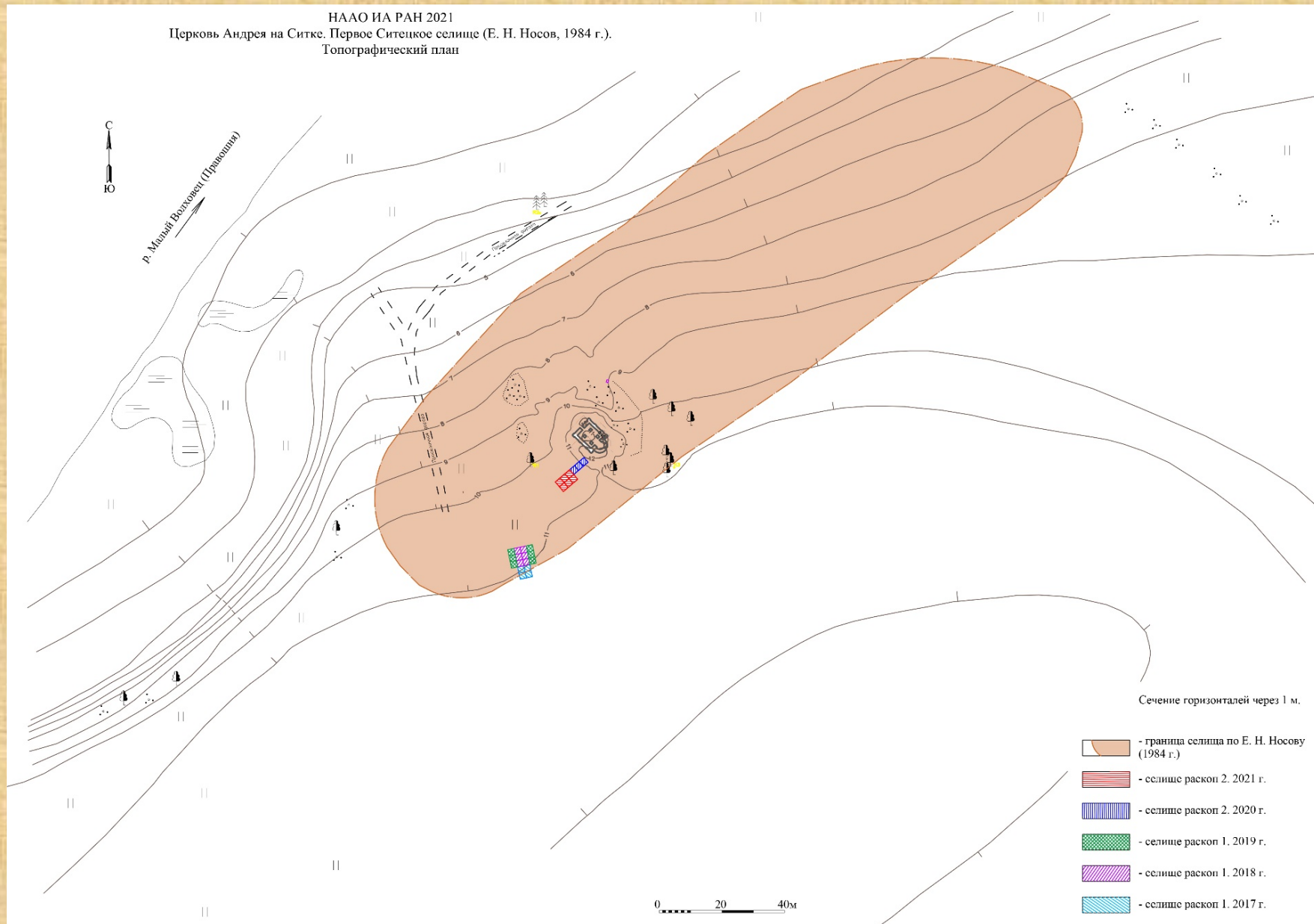

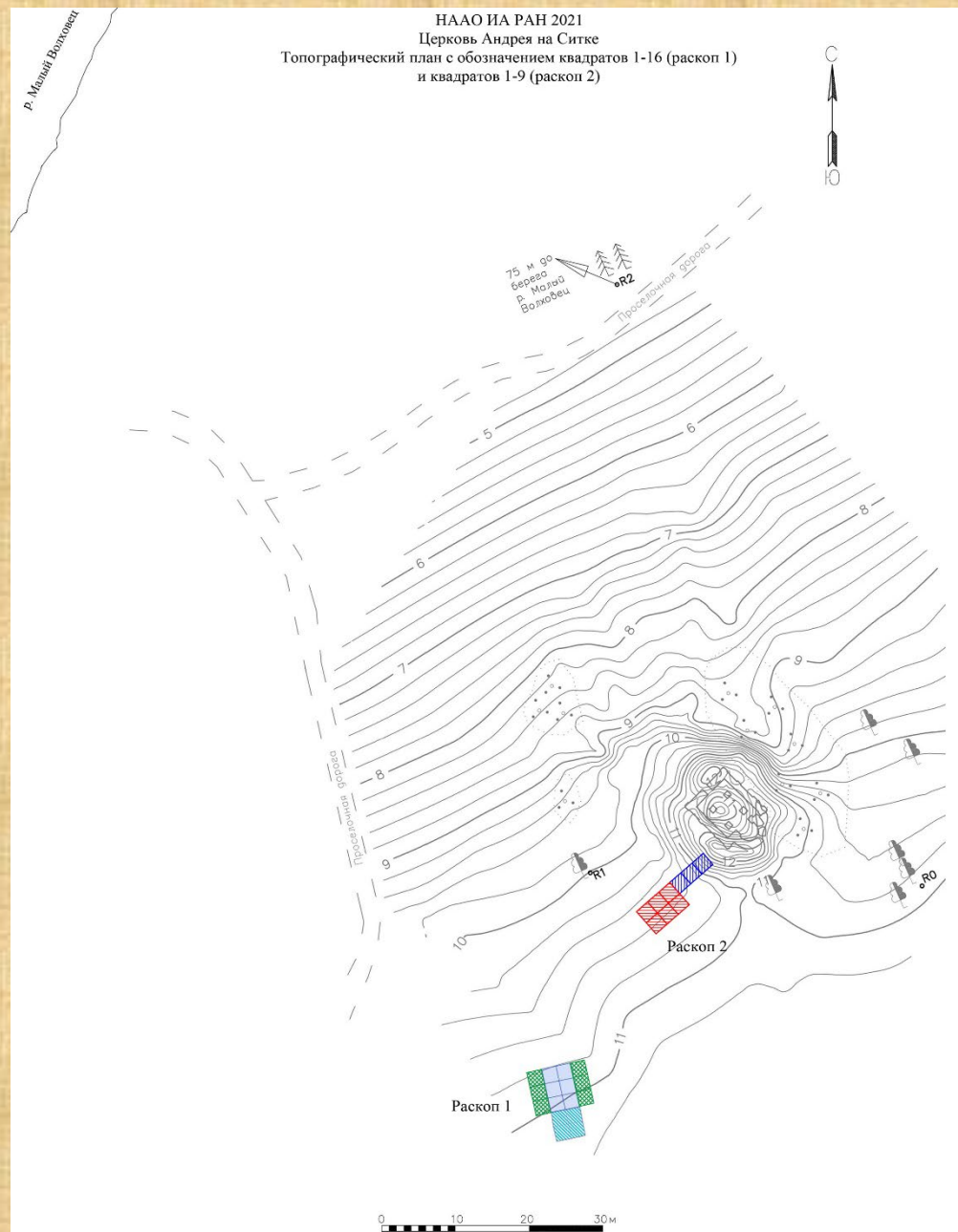

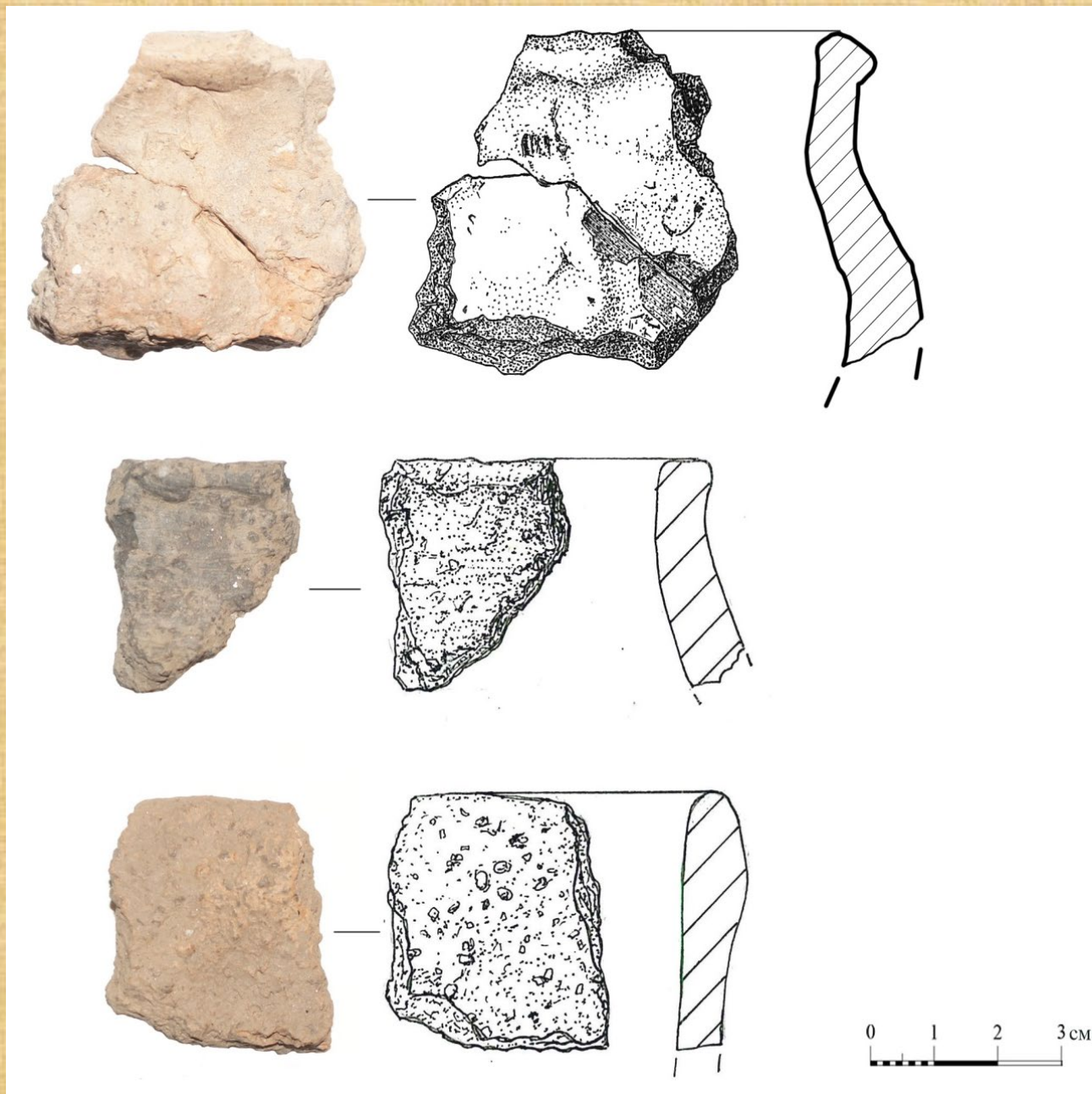


The plan of the medieval settlement on the Sitetskiy Monastery site (Nosov, 1984)





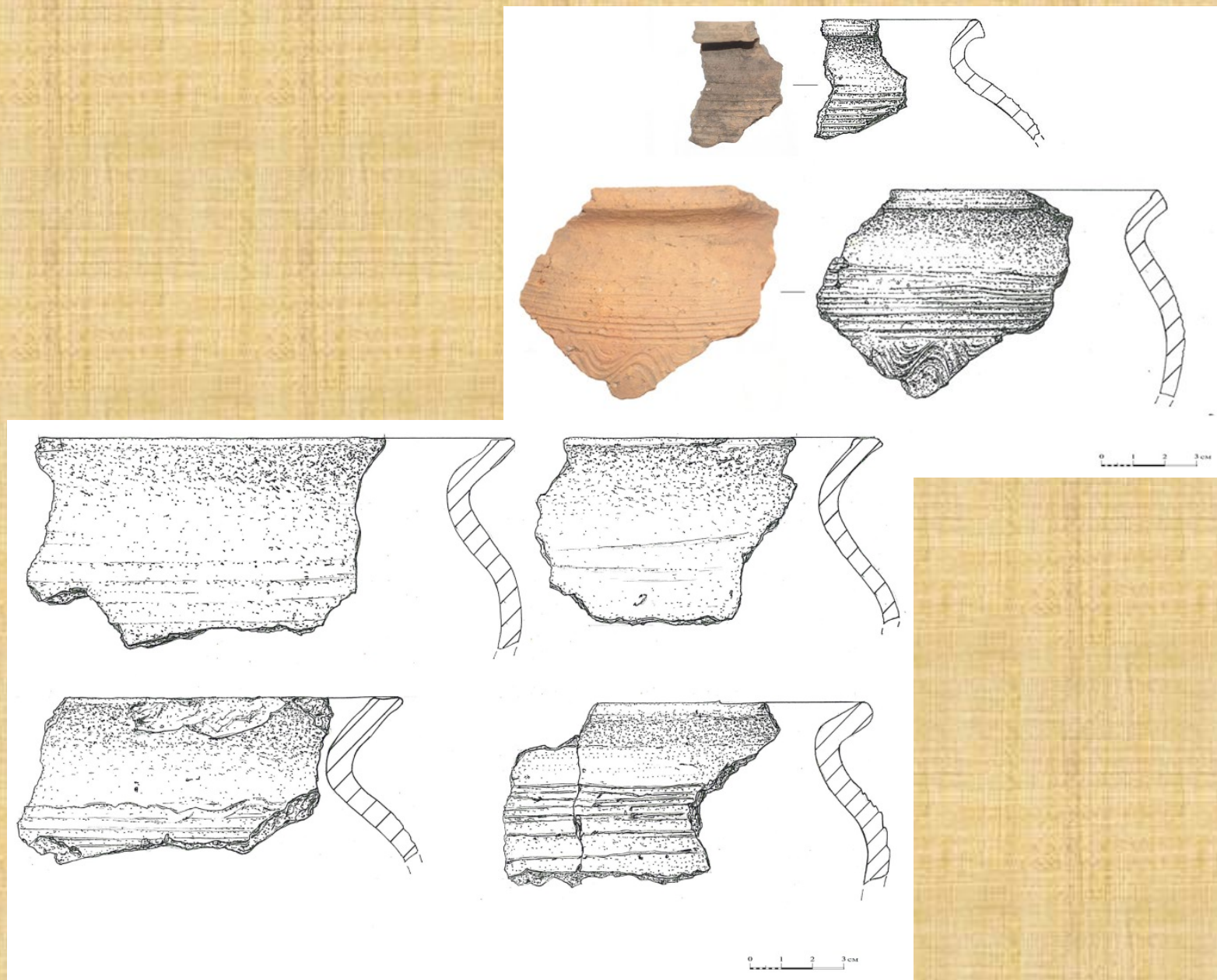
Plan of the former Sitetskiy Monastery territory (2014)



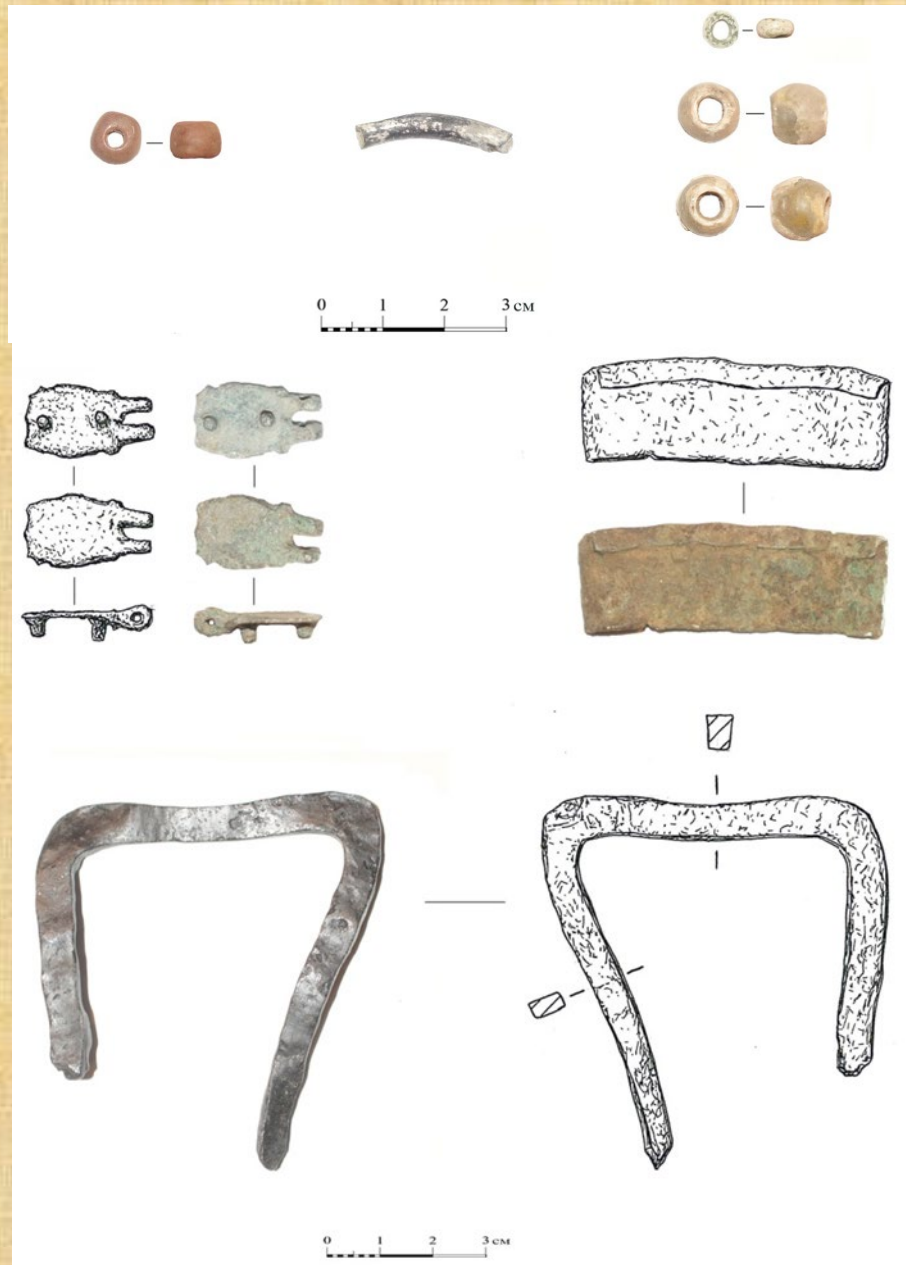

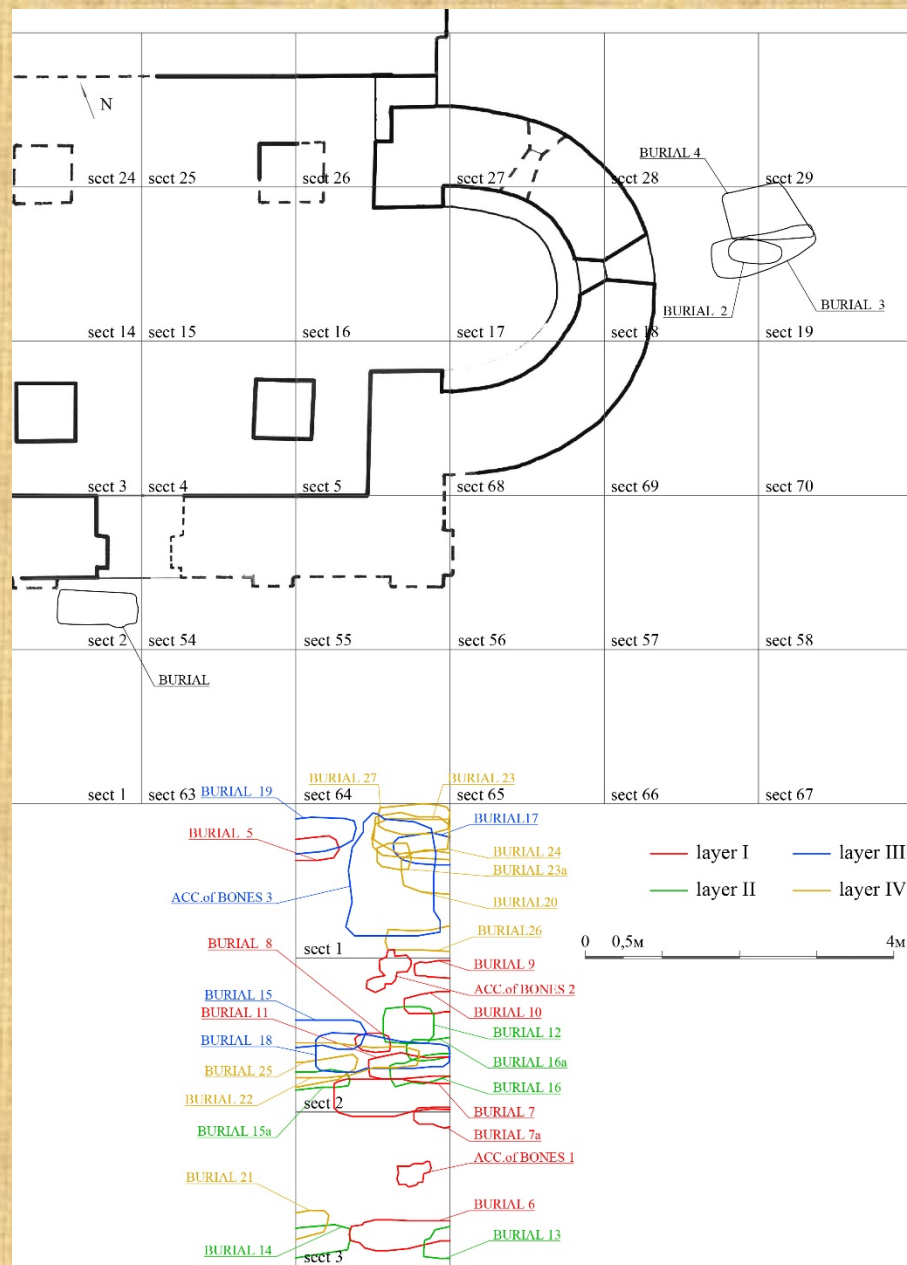

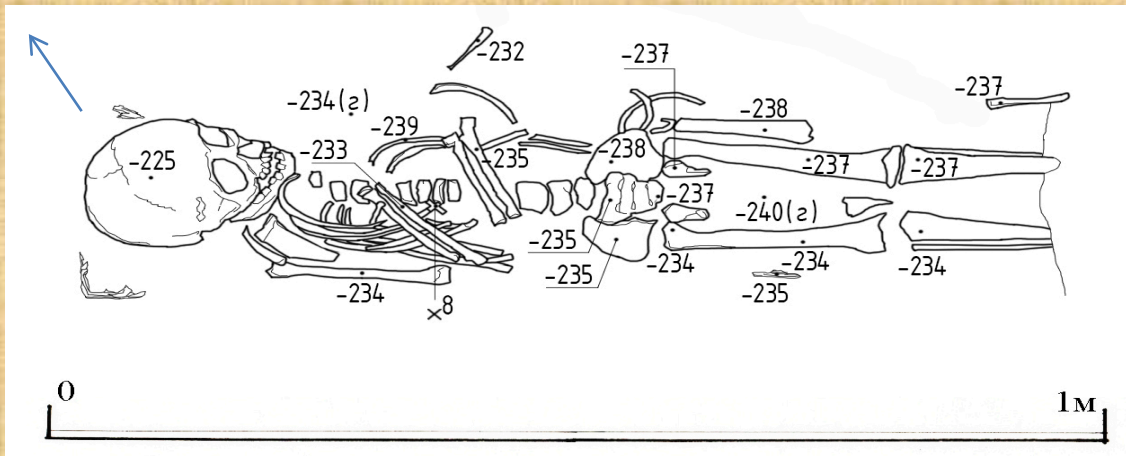

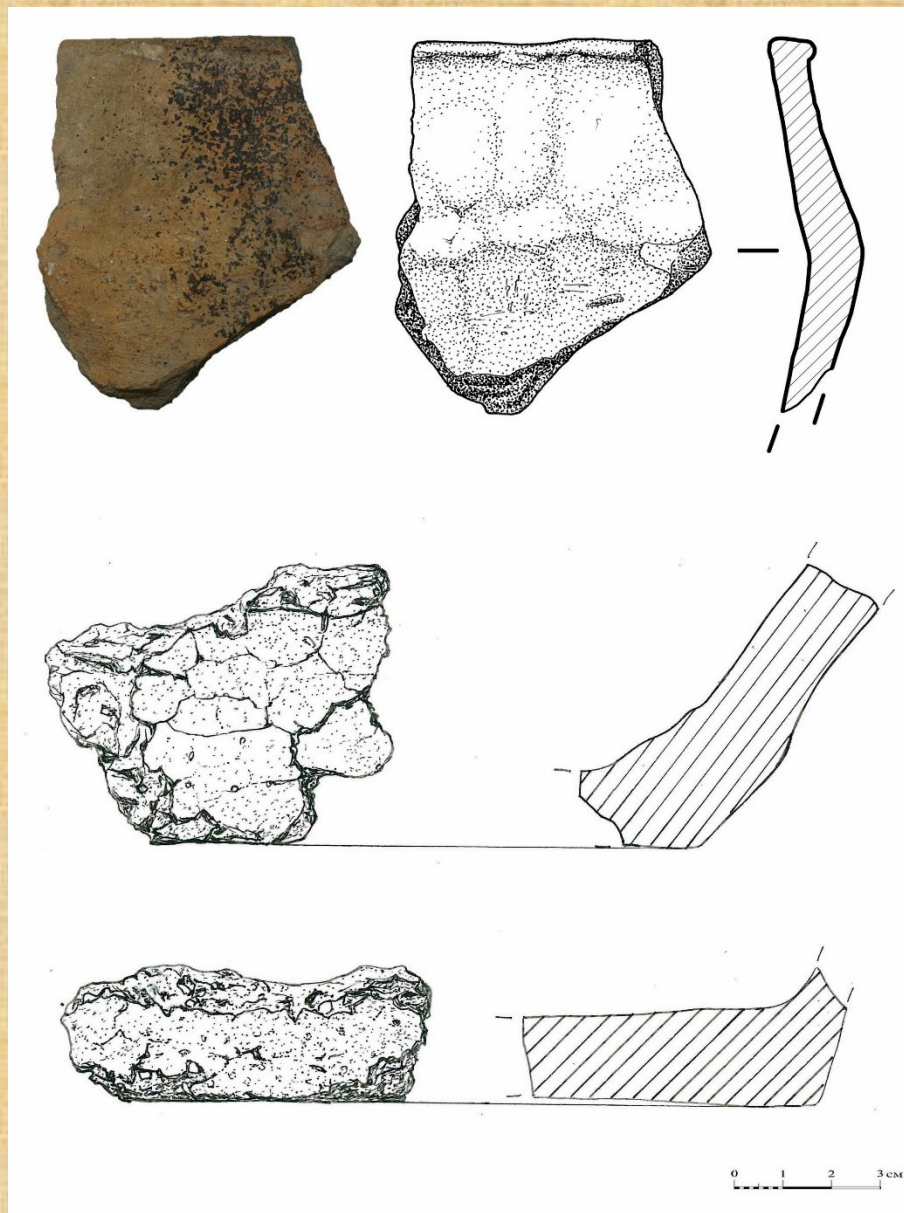

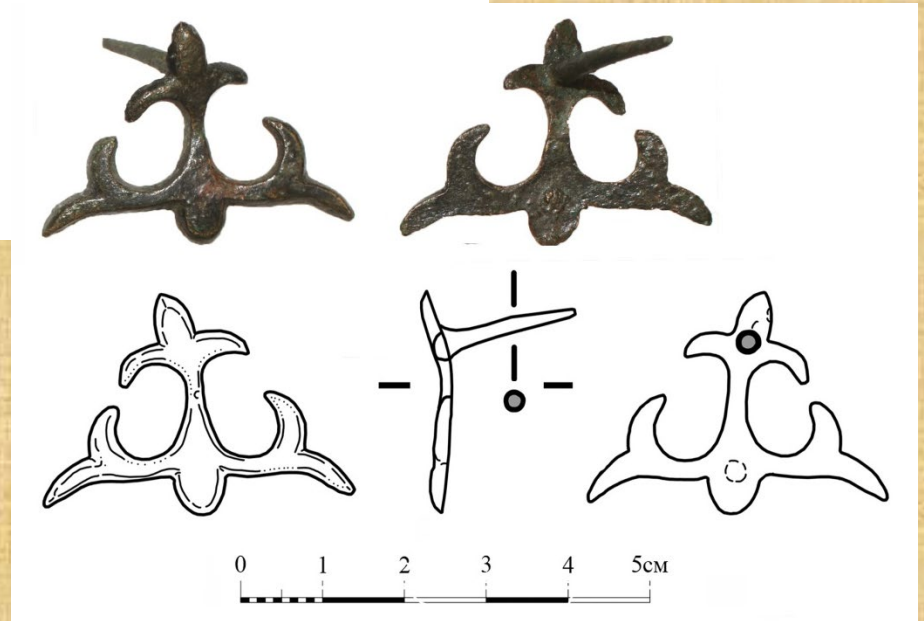
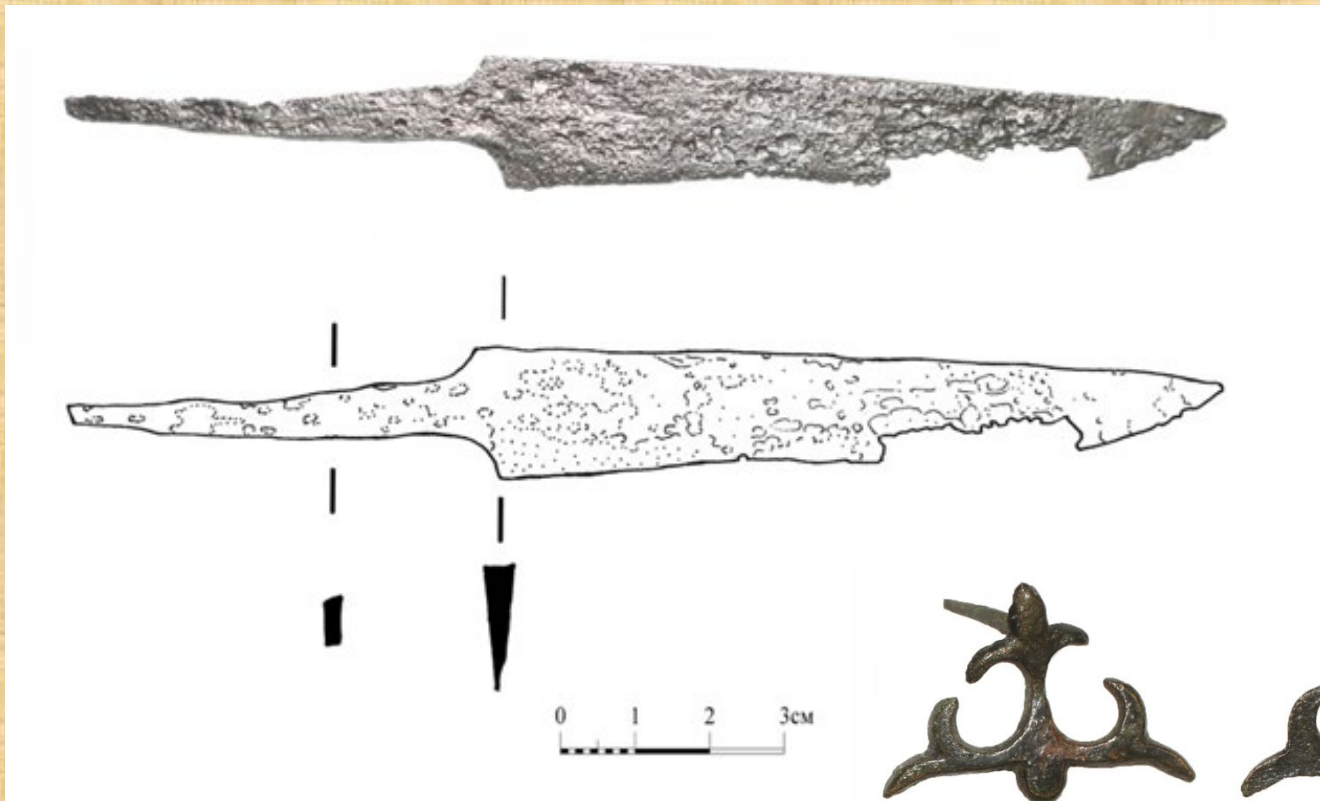

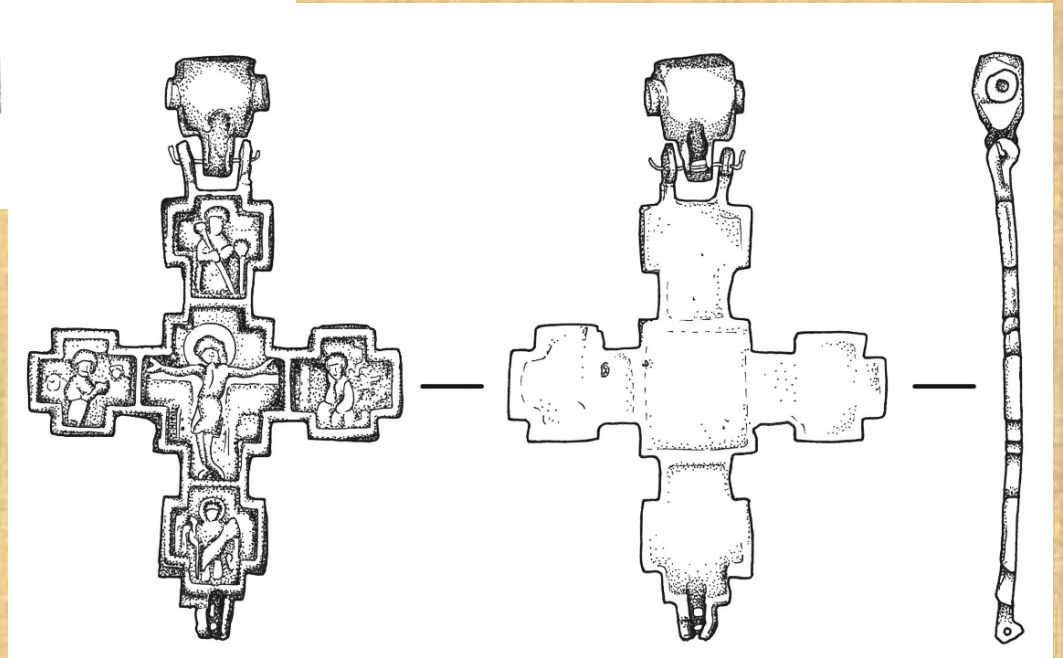
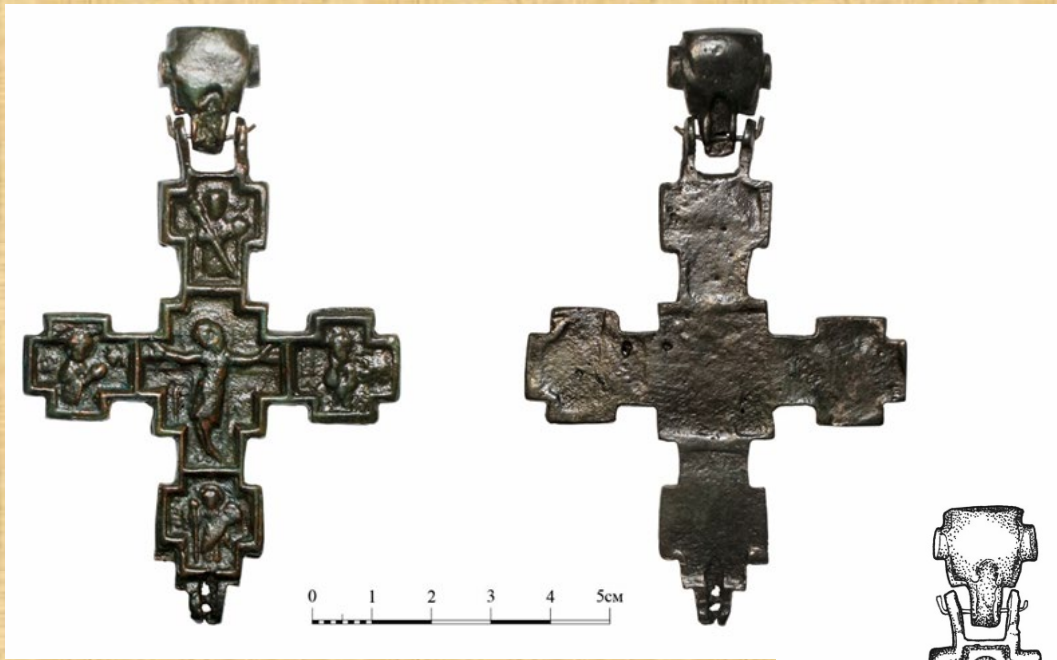

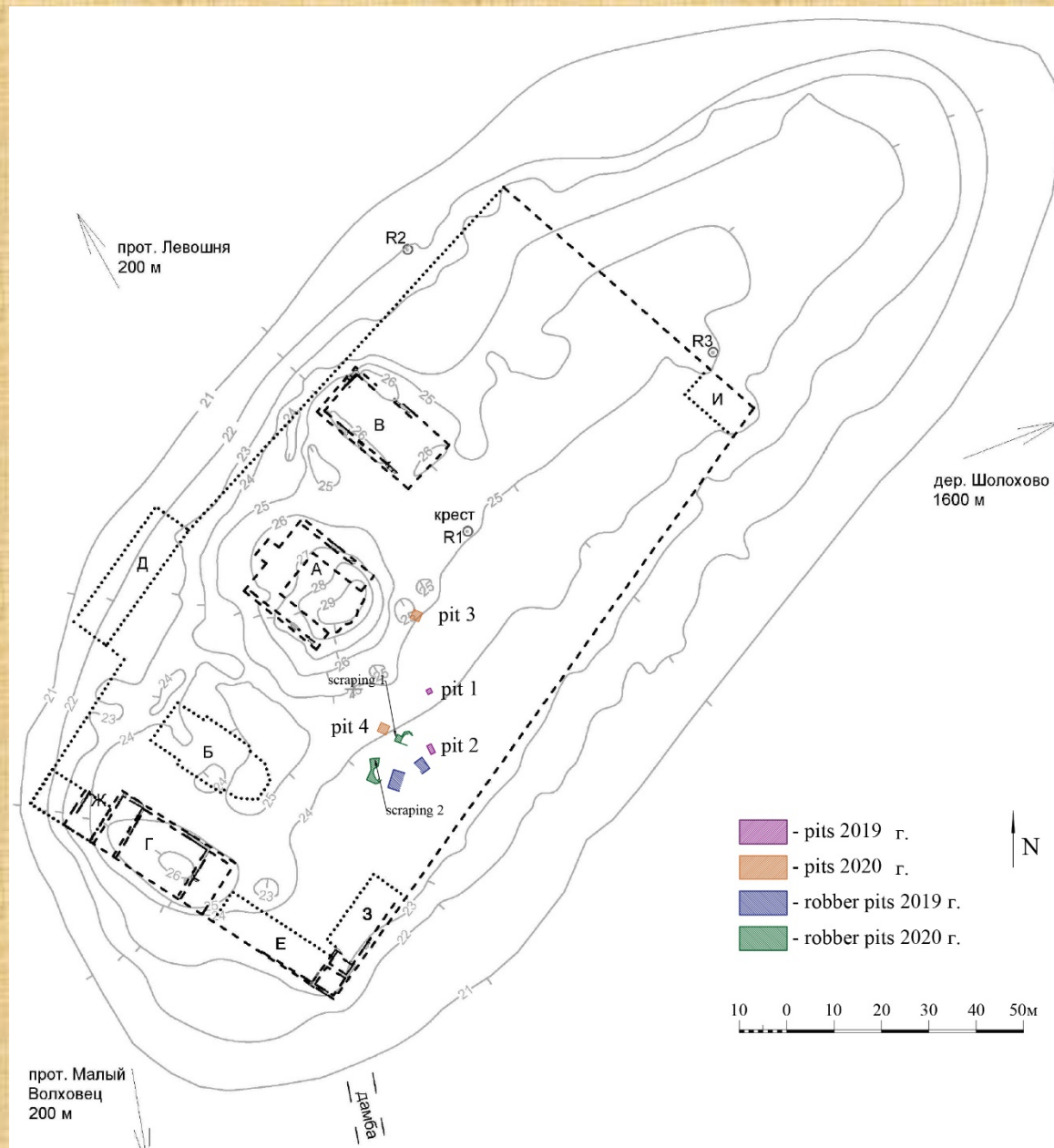
